BIG NEWS! Stipend Maximum Has Increased to \$19,100

Starting June 1, 2016, the BHMT [Individual Stipend Program](#) (ISP) and the [RN-to-BSN Program](#) has increased the lifetime maximum benefit to **\$19,100** for eligible employees.

If you are a current ISP or RN-to-BSN participant:

- Your new stipend benefit maximum increases from to \$16,000 to \$19,100. This means you have an additional \$3,100 and may continue utilizing your stipend benefit as usual.

If you were previously in the ISP or the RN-to-BSN Program and exhausted your \$16,000 fund:

- You now have an additional \$3,100 to use. You may have to re-apply for the program depending on your previous participation.

3 Tips for Career Development

When we think about the words 'career development' and 'relationships', we may immediately think of building our network, but in today's changing work environment, the connection between **careers and relationships** is much more about mutual learning, reciprocity, and interdependence. According to Douglas Hall, an expert in building careers within organizations, this "relationship

approach” to career development is dependent on a “willingness to see relationships at work as important sites of personal learning and development.”

How do you ensure that this is happening in your career? **Here are 3 tips:**

- **With co-workers and team members:** Be open to the background, skills and strengths of all the team members whether you are the senior or junior member. Sharing perspectives from diversity of experiences whether related to age, gender, culture, or ethnicity can enhance your effectiveness and career success.
- **With colleagues from other disciplines:** Any opportunity to share learnings with colleagues from different professional disciplines is significant. Increasing your knowledge through communication with those from disciplines other than your own can not only support good member care but also expand your own understanding of the wide range and depth of clinical care.
- **With a manager:** One may or may not feel comfortable with a manager based on the length of time working together, similarity of style, etc., but one thing about your relationship with your manager is that it is always significant for your career. Remember, you can always learn from and with your manager. This is a result of your manager’s knowledge of and observations of your skills and strengths and the opportunity for not only feedback but a mutually open dialogue about your specific potential for growth in the current job.



You can also develop your communication skills through a respectful and assertive sharing of your own ideas with your manager.
