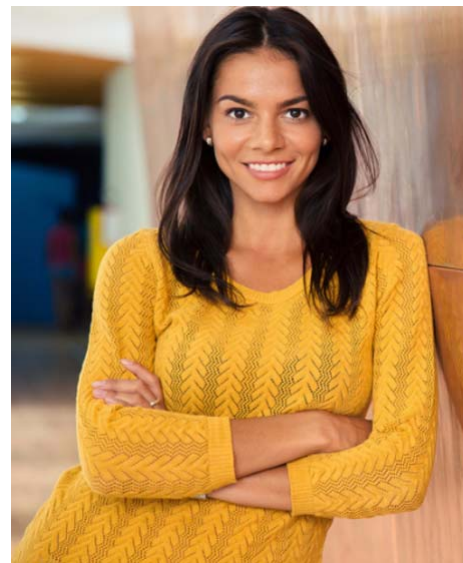
Here are 3 ways to **pinpoint your passions** and to help you start turning them into career choices:
