SCAL Service Representative Shows Why It's So Important To Finish What You Start

While working as a Service Representative, Julie Cardwell had the desire to go back to school and work towards her college degree. Realizing that the healthcare industry is constantly evolving, she began to think about her future at KP and where she wanted to be in her career. In 2014, Julie signed up to complete her prerequisite

(CTU) and was also able to attend <u>Coastline Community College</u> concurrently without taking time off work. After completing over 70 units in one year, all paid for by BHMT, and receiving a 4.0 in all of her classes, Julie then transferred to Humboldt State University.

"People always think that there's a catch," she says, "You do not have to front the money to participate in the programs. It's better to go through an employer-sponsored program because it can give you that much more incentive to complete it. It's a win-win."

Julie is now paying only \$1,800 out-of-pocket for her entire BA program. "It's amazing to me that BHMT has allowed me to get my bachelor's at the cost of one state class," she says, "I am so thankful."

With her persistence to achieve, Julie will complete her bachelor's in 3 years. With absolutely no plans on slowing down anytime soon, she is already planning her next steps to continue to be a benefit within the organization.


