BIG NEWS! The Stipend Maximum Has Increased to \$20,263

Starting January 1, 2018, the BHMT [Individual Stipend Program \(ISP\)](#) and the [RN-to-BSN Program's](#) lifetime maximum benefit increased to **\$20,263** for all eligible employees.

Individual Stipend Program



If you are a current ISP or RN-to-BSN participant:

- Your new stipend benefit maximum increases from to \$19,673 to \$20,263. This means you have additional funds and may continue utilizing your stipend benefit as usual

If you were previously in the ISP or the RN-to-BSN Program and exhausted your \$19,673 fund:

- You now have additional funds to use. **Please note:** You may have to re-apply for the program depending on your previous participation.

Renew Your TAP Application for 2018

Did you know that your KP Tuition Reimbursement account refreshes each calendar year? That means, if you've used BHMT's [Tuition Assistance Program \(TAP\)](#) in the past, you must re-apply and receive your manager's approval annually.

Please, submit a new application or re-apply even if you are not expecting to take any courses. Your application will stay on file until you are ready!
